If you have professed Christ and have been baptized by immersion, yet are not a member of a church you may join by a statement of faith.

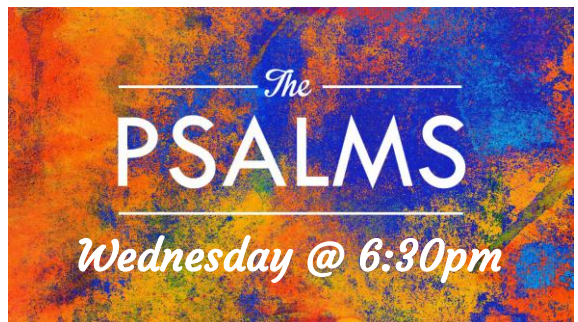
