How To Become a Member:

If you are a Christian coming from another Baptist church, you may simply request membership here, and we will contact your former church as a courtesy to let them know of your transfer. This is typically called joining "by letter." Do not worry, you do not have the letter. We will take care of that for you.

If you are a new Christian, or have never been baptized, then joining by baptism is appropriate for you. Baptism is an act of commitment and obedience to Christ who commanded us to be baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Immersion baptism is very important in the Baptist tradition because it is symbolic of being raised to new life in Christ.

If you have professed Christ and have been baptized by immersion, yet are not a member of a church you may join by a statement of faith.
