How to become a member of Fairview:

If you are a Christian and are currently a member of another Baptist Church, you may simply request that your membership be moved here. We will take care of that for you.

If you are a new Christian and have never been baptized, then joining by baptism is appropriate for you. Baptism is an act of obedience and commitment to Christ who commanded us to be baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Immersion baptism is very important in the Baptist tradition because it is symbolic to being raised to new life.

If you have professed Christ and have been baptized by immersion yet are not a member of a church, you may join by a statement of faith.


There is great joy in serving Christ's Church.
